



NOTICE OF PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

WINCHESTER CITY (OFF STREET) PARKING PLACES ORDER 2003 (VARIATION NO. 10) ORDER 2021

Winchester City Council with the consent of Hampshire County Council proposes making the above road traffic regulation order. The effect of this order will be to introduce a new car park in Bar End Road, Winchester, Hampshire, known as the Winchester Sport & Leisure Park.
