NOTICE OF INTENDED DEDICATION OF LAND

Notice is hereby given under sections 123 (1) and (2A) of the Local Government Act 1972 that Winchester City Council intends to dedicate an area of open space land in favour of Hampshire County Council. The land is at Dyson Drive, Winchester, Hampshire and is shown coloured blue on drawing number CJ009503 HEH 44301214 DR ZL 0002 ('Open Space Land'). The total area of land to be dedicated to Hampshire County Council is approximately 5.6m2, and consists of a strip of land running along the edge of the existing footway between the wall and the start of the grass verge.

The Open Space Land is to be dedicated by Winchester City Council as highway maintainable at the public expense. Hampshire County Council is the highway authority for the area and the Open Space Land is intended to allow the extension of a shared use path (for walking and cycling) from Worthy Road into Dyson Drive and will ensure that the path is to LTN1/20 standards. No consideration is to be paid by Hampshire County Council for the dedication.
